## Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)

Our ATAR results over time show that we are consistently achieving results higher than similar schools. In the last few years, a very high percentage of our students have been offered places at university in their first choice of program. Given the trend to early offers for places at university, many of our Year 12 students receive offers for their places during their final year.

## Technical and Further Education

## 1 - Fees, charges & Discounts

*St Andrew's Grammar keeps fees as low as possible while maintaining the highest quality educational experience for all students. Fees cover costs that are an integral part of the curriculum, giving each student access to excellent learning resources and facilities.*

### Annual Fees

Annual School fees consist of Tuition Fees (Sect. 2) & Levies (sect. 3).

### Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of \$90 per application is payable on submission of your application for enrolment.

### Enrolment Fee

A non-refundable, non-transferable enrolment fee of \$1300 per student is payable on acceptance of offer for enrolment of which \$250 will be deducted off the first year of enrolment.

**Please Note:** if your child is entering pre-kindy, \$250 from the acceptance fee will be held until the following year when the child begins Kindergarten.

### Discounts

If more than one discount is applicable concurrently (for example; sibling, scholarship, and advance payment discounts), these get applied on amounts after the other discount has been applied.

### Sibling Discounts

Sibling discounts are applied to tuition fees only, and are offered as follows:

- Second sibling attending concurrently: 20%
- Third sibling attending concurrently: 40%
- Fourth sibling attending concurrently: 65%

**A late payment fee of \$150 may be charged on accounts not paid by the due date.** Direct Debits returned unpaid may also incur the late payment fee. In addition, discounts may be forfeited for accounts not settled by the due date. If the tuition fees remain outstanding at the end of a term, the Principal reserves the right to suspend or terminate your child's enrolment.

## 7 – Withdrawal of Students

### Withdrawal Before Commencing at the School

If you withdraw your child after paying the Acceptance Fee but before they start at the school, you must provide **at least one full term's notice** by completing the *Withdrawal of Enrolment* form (available from the Admissions Office). If proper notice is not provided, a **cancellation fee equal to one term's tuition** will be charged.

Examples:

- For students beginning in **Term 1**, notice must be provided **by the end of Term 3** of the previous year.
- For students beginning in **Term 3**, notice must be provided **by the end of Term 1** of the same year.

### Withdrawal After Commencing at the School

If you withdraw your child after they have started at the school, whether the withdrawal is initiated by us or by the school, you are required to provide **at least one full term's notice** by completing the *Withdrawal of Enrolment* form (available from the Admissions Office). If proper notice is not provided, a **cancellation fee equal to one term's tuition** will be charged.

Examples:

- For students leaving at the **beginning of Term 1**, notice must be provided **by the end of Term 3** of the previous year.
- For students leaving at the **beginning of Term 3**, notice must be provided **by the end of Term 1** of the same year.

## Scholarship Program 2027

The Board of St Andrew's Grammar offers academic scholarships for students entering Year 7, 9 and 11 each year. These scholarships are awarded to students who perform well on the ACER scholarship test held each year in March. The scholarships take effect in the following year.

### What's in the test?

Humanities, Mathematics and English (written expression) are tested. Students must demonstrate the ability to interpret, infer, deduce and think critically. You cannot study specifically for this test.

### Is there a cost?

The test is designed and graded by the Australian Council for Educational Research. ACER's fee is \$140 per registration.

### Why apply for a scholarship?

The scholarship takes the form of a fee reduction determined each year by the school board.

### Who can sit the test?

The scholarship is for students who are currently in Year 6, 8 and 10 (in 2026).

Saturday, 14th March 2026
